



IREX 2010 – International River Expedition

18th – 24th July 2010. River Körös, Hungary

Topic: Forest management and habitat protection on the Great Hungarian Plane

What?

The second International River Expedition (IREX 2010) is going to be a 5 day long canoe tour, which will take place along the River Körös in east Hungary. This is a unique way to experience this beautiful river and is suitable to learn more about the connection between the river, the forestry and the game management on the Great Hungarian Plane.

Where?

We will paddle with canoes on the River Körös from the Romanian border. This river is calm flat water which is suitable for less experienced oarsmen too.

Preliminary program

18th Arrive to Gyula

19th – 23th Paddle from Gyula to Szarvas (about 90km total)

24th Depart from Szarvas

During the trip we will visit the castle of Gyula, special nature conservation areas, the Great Bustard reserve (*Otis tarda*, the biggest bird of Europe), Hungarian specialties from Békés, and so on. We will sleep in camps thus own tent and sleeping bag is required.

Application deadline: 31st of March

Please note that limited places available only for 25 participants. The first 3 applicants per LC can register. First comes, first served.

If there are more than three people applying from one LC they will be placed on a waiting list.

If there are any remaining vacancies after 1st of April, then they will be filled from this waiting list.

Participation fee: 65 euro (or possibly less, depending on the sponsors)
